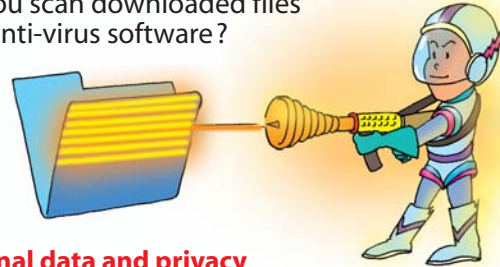

Have you installed a personal firewall at your PC?

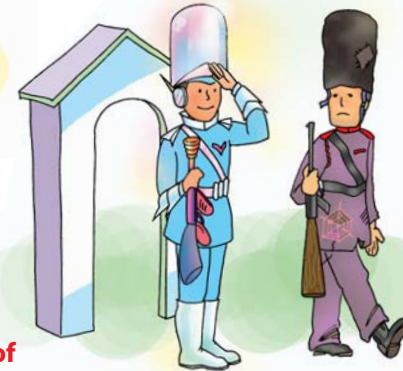


User ID and passwords
